

Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) Policy

Vision

To create an ecosystem that encourages creativity, innovation, and protection of intellectual property generated through academic and research activities.

Objectives

- Promote awareness of intellectual property rights among students and faculty.
- Facilitate the identification, protection, and commercialization of intellectual property.
- Encourage patent filing, copyrights, trademarks, and design registrations.
- Ensure ethical and legal compliance in all IPR activities.

Scope

This policy applies to all IPR generated by:

- Faculty members
- Students (UG & PG)
- Research scholars
- Staff and collaborators engaged in institutional projects

Ownership & Rights

- IP created using significant college resources will be jointly owned by the creator and the institution.
- In case of externally funded projects, ownership will follow the terms of the funding agency.
- Independent work without using college resources will belong solely to the creator.

Types of IPR Covered

- Patents
- Copyrights (e.g., books, software, course materials)
- Trademarks
- Industrial designs
- Trade secrets and confidential information

Filing & Registration Process

- Faculty/students must disclose potential IP to the IPR Cell.
- The IPR Cell will evaluate novelty, commercial viability, and file applications.
- Legal and professional support will be provided by the institution.
- All filings must follow Indian and international IPR laws.

Revenue Sharing

- Revenue from commercialized IP shall be shared as:
 - **Creator:** 70%
 - **Institution:** 30%
- In case of multiple creators, distribution will be made based on contribution.




Roles & Responsibilities

- **IPR Cell:** Manage awareness, documentation, registration, and policy implementation.
- **Faculty/Researchers:** Ensure disclosure and compliance.
- **Students:** Seek guidance and support from IPR Cell for filing.

Awareness & Training

- Workshops, seminars, and webinars on IPR and innovation
- Collaboration with patent attorneys and experts
- Integration of IPR awareness in curriculum
